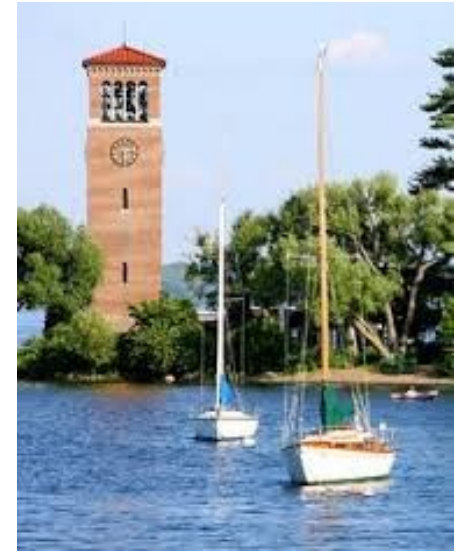

**Stella Rimington**

**Former Director General, MI-5**

Dame Stella Rimington is the retired director general of the British Security Service (MI5). Appointed director general in 1992, she was the first woman to hold the post and the first director general to be publicly named on appointment. Rimington joined MI5 as a full-time employee in 1969. She worked in all the main fields of the service's responsibilities — counter subversion, counter espionage and counter terrorism — becoming successively director of all three branches. During her tenure as director general, Rimington pursued a policy of greater openness for MI5, giving the 1994 Dimpleby Lecture on BBC TV. She retired in April 1996. She is also the author of an autobiography, *Open Secret*; and the spy novels *Rip Tide*; *At Risk*; *Secret Asset*; *Illegal Action*; *Dead Line*; *Present Danger*; *The Geneva Trap*; and *Close Call*.

## **2 p.m. Lecture - Shadi Hamid**

Dr. Shadi Hamid is a senior fellow at the Brookings Institution and the author of *Islamic Exceptionalism: How the Struggle Over Islam is Reshaping the World* (St. Martin's Press), which was shortlisted for the 2017 Lionel Gelber Prize, for best book on foreign affairs. He is also a contributing editor for *The Atlantic*. His previous book *Temptations of Power: Islamists and Illiberal Democracy in a New Middle East* (Oxford University Press) was named a Foreign Affairs Best Book of 2014.

Hamid served as director of research at the Brookings Doha Center until January 2014. Prior to joining Brookings, he was director of research at the Project on Middle East Democracy (POMED) and a Hewlett Fellow at Stanford University's Center on Democracy, Development, and the Rule of Law. Hamid received his B.S. and M.A. from Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service, and his Ph.D. in political science from Oxford University.
